	transmitter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– widely spread</li> <li>– respect “is well received” by places/inhabitants home</li> </ul>
	receiver	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– be designed and developed to capture attention</li> <li>– be designed and developed in order to persuade receiver to read the DICRIM</li> <li>– be designed and developed in order to promote understanding and recording of information</li> </ul>
Major phenomena/ protective measures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– floods, earthquakes, etc.</li> <li>– dams, dikes, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– provides information on major phenomena and on protective measures taken by town to overcome them</li> </ul>
