Indeed, we are developing a methodology to be used in decision making processes to prioritise interventions in historic city centres, exemplified for Bucharest City Centre.

Cultural heritage is a valuable asset in itself, but also because of its contribution to the creation of the identity of locals. Interventions have to be made to preserve cultural heritage in all phases of the disaster cycle: from the preventive retrofit to the reconstruction. We have addressed the importance of the local's perception in the previous reply. The paper shows which items can be included in the prioritisation. created and recorded for the interwar buildings.
