It is also important that with your re-submission you include (i) a detailed list of the changes made and (ii) a list with your responses to the comments and suggestions made by the referees.

From an editorial point of view, it is important that you clarify what is the scientific / technological relevance and innovation of your work, in comparison to the existing literature. It is also important that you improve the quality of the English and the technical language, and the quality and readability of the accompanying figures.

I look forward to receiving a revised version of your work, which I will send to the same reviewers who examined your original submission. Based on their comments on your revised work, and my own judgment, I will make a final decision on your work.
