

## ***Interactive comment on “New estimates of potential impacts of sea level rise and coastal floods in Poland” by D. Paprotny and P. Terefenko***

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First of all, I would like to thank the reviewers and the authors for this interesting discussion about a very challenging topic. The two reviewers provided a series of critical issues that should be fixed in order to make the entire work ready for publication. However both recognized the potential value of the research.

In details the first reviewer recommended a rejection underlining the fact that “the manuscript is limited in some aspects which, although largely acknowledged, reduce the value of the outputs of the work that the authors present”. In addition he/she highlighted the uncertainties related to the future impacts of socio economic development, very difficult to estimate looking only at a single projection for future population.

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The second reviewer raised major issues, not so difficult to fix after a suitable rewriting. The authors provided suitable replies, even if I was expecting a more detailed reply to the reviewer #1.

I think that the authors should have a chance to propose a revised version of the paper after major changes. I strongly recommend to provide a very detailed rebuttal and paper, addressing all the suggestions raised by both the reviewers.

Please note that this editorial decision does not guarantee that the paper will be accepted for final publication in NHESS. A decision will be made when the revised version will be available, and will be evaluated.

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
