We are very thankful to Anonymous Referee #1 for his/her contributions, support and comments about our manuscript and conclusions. We also share the concern not to be able to present all data of the wind directions in this manuscript, as this is has been a complete paper, which is under the process of being published. Nonetheless, for the interest of the Anonymous Referee #1, the clouds filled with ashes in Ecuador based on four different volcanoes, from 1999-2014 and the respective wind directions are illustrated below.
