(a) Tables. Please report precision to the same amount for all values (not 0.2 for one value and 0.25 for another, the first should be 0.20).

(b) It is good they have significance levels for their trend values (gradients). In my own papers, when looking at temperature trends for Mauna Loa, I also tried to give some idea of the actual \pm error (many ways to do) based on the data, to give the reader a stronger idea of how much variability on the gradient there is.

(c) Figure 2. Please have them put the horizontal line with labels at the bottom—it is hard to see where it is now.
